

#### TYPE 1

## **CUT OFF WHEELS & CHOP SAW WHEELS**

- · Available in diameters from 4 1/2" to 14'

- · Used for cutting various metals



#### **TYPE 27**

#### **GRINDING DISC**

- · Available in diameters from 4 1/2" to 9"
- · Used with angle grinders
- Made using resin bonded reinforced construction for greater strength and durability
- · Used for deburring and blending



#### **TYPE 29**



- · Available in 4 1/2" and 5" diameters
- · Available in 40, 60, and 80 grit
- · Used with angle grinders
- Surface pliability prevents burning of work material
- · Used for deburring and blending
